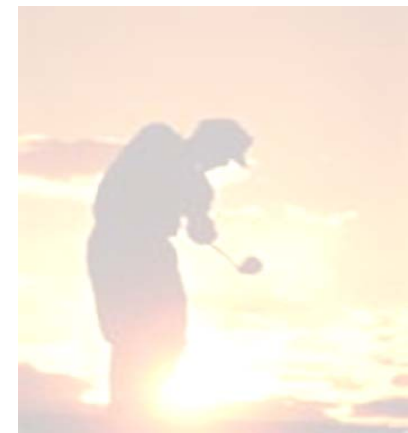

Helping Families of Fallen Heroes

Immediately after a firefighter dies in the line of duty, the Foundation provides survivors with a place to turn. Families can receive emotional assistance through a Survivor Support Network for as long as they need it. This contact with other fire service survivors can be an important part of their healing. Families receive a quarterly newsletter and specialized resources through a Lending Library. The National Fallen Firefighter website www.firehero.org provides information on benefits, the Memorial Weekend, and other programs. Spouses, children, and stepchildren are



eligible for scholarships to assist with education and job training.

Scholarships Through National Fallen Firefighter Foundation

The Foundation's scholarship program can help spouses, children, and stepchildren with educational and job training costs. We can also help survivors identify other sources of educational assistance.
